FLORA AND FAUNA

CASA DE FLORES PLANTS

Bougainvillea's

Planted 7, 5 gallon size plants, South Side of our building.

San Diego Red, Source: Boething Treeland Farms, Portola Valley CA

Native to South America, and takes full sun. San Diego Red is one of the most cold tolerant and larger bougainvillea's. The color you see is in the bracts (leaves). In areas south, these plants are grown as trees.



Geranium Maderense

Planted in right planting bed.

This is a monocarpic biennial, and is drought tolerant. Source Annie's, Richmond, CA.

Pink Flowers now, will die after flowering, but produces additional plants (self sowing). Native to Madeira.
